### 1. Power BI Free

 Intended For: Individual users exploring personal data analysis and visualization.

### Capabilities:

- Connect to various data sources.

- Cannot share content with other users.
- Cannot consume content shared by others unless it's in a Premium capacity.

### 2. Power BI Pro

- All features available in the Free version.
- o Share reports, dashboards, and datasets with other Pro users.
- Collaborate in shared workspaces.
- Export reports to various formats.
- Integrate with other Microsoft services.
- **Pricing**: Approximately £7.50 per user/month.

### 3. Power BI Premium

• **Intended For**: Organizations requiring advanced features, larger data capacities, and broad content distribution without per-user licensing.

- All Pro features.
- Access to advanced features like paginated reports and Al functionalities.
- Larger model sizes and increased refresh rates.
- Pricing: Approximately £15 per user/month.

# o Per Capacity:

- Dedicated cloud compute and storage resources.
- Allows content sharing with users who have Free licenses.
- Supports larger datasets and higher refresh frequencies.
- Pricing: Starts at around £3,500 per capacity/month.

### 4. Power BI Embedded

• Intended For: Independent software vendors (ISVs) and developers who want to embed Power BI visuals into their applications.

# · Capabilities:

- Embed dashboards and reports into custom applications.
- o Pay-as-you-go pricing model based on usage.
- Pricing: Varies based on the chosen capacity and usage patterns.
